Camp Nurse

The Camp Nurse is responsible for the oversight of the campers' health needs.

- The Camp Nurse reports to the Camp Director.
- The Camp Nurse consults with the Camp Physician when necessary.

Essential Job Responsibilities

- Check all health records prior to commencement of each session.
- Document problems and/or concerns and specific medical information for camp staff.
- Consult with campers' physician(s) regarding specific health needs when appropriate.
- With Camp Director, check in all campers on first day of camp each week.
- Review all medications and set up medication log.
- Review medication administration with Camp Director and Asst. Director.
- Administer all medications and check in with campers with any health concerns.
- Provide instruction to staff regarding the management of allergies, medication, and other health concerns of campers.

Essential Job Information

- Sunset Point Camp is an overnight camp. The Camp Nurse position is not a live in position.
- 20 hours a week
- Camp dates for staff are June 21st until August 12th
- Campers first day is June 26th
- The weeks run from Sunday to Friday

Qualifications

- Must be an RN or LPN, RN preferred
- Certified in advanced First Aid, CPR, and AED
- Experience working with latency age youth – ages 6-14
- Preferably live within 20-minute commuting distance of camp in case of emergency
